

# Mumbai woman who was raped, assaulted with rod in private parts dies in hospital

Mumbai, September 11

A 34-YEAR-OLD WOMAN, who was raped and brutalised with a rod by a man inside a stationary tempo in suburban Sakinaka area died during treatment at a hospital in the early hours of Saturday, police said.

The crime, which bore a chilling similarity to the 2012 'Nirbhaya' gang-rape case of Delhi, took place in the wee hours of Friday. The suspect who had been arrested within a few hours of the incident has been now charged with murder.

While the city police formed a Special Investigation Team to probe the incident, opposition BJP demanded capital punishment for the accused and questioned if women were safe in Maharashtra.

Maharashtra chief minister Uddhav Thackeray termed the incident as a "blot on humanity". "The trial in the case will be held on a fast track and the victim, who succumbed to injuries today, will get justice," he said in a statement. He has discussed the case with state Home Minister Dilip Walse-Patil and Mumbai Police Commissioner Hemant Nagrale, Thackeray added.



The Sakinaka area in the western suburbs has several industrial units.

According to police, accused Mohan Chouhan (45) worked as a driver and lived on the pavement in the same area. Besides being raped, the victim woman was assaulted with an iron rod in her private parts and lost a lot of blood, a police official said.

She had also been stabbed with a knife, he added. Police commissioner Nagrale told reporters that the crime came to light when the watchman of a company located on Khairani Road called the police control room and said that a man was seen thrashing a woman.

Police reached the spot within 10 minutes and found the victim inside a parked tempo. As her condition was serious, they decided to take her

to hospital in the same vehicle so as to save time. They got the key of the tempo from the watchman and drove her to Rajwadi hospital in suburban Ghatkopar, the commissioner said.

The police also obtained CCTV footage of the spot. A man seen leaving the tempo was identified as Mohan Chouhan who hails from Jaunpur, Uttar Pradesh, the commissioner said. He was arrested and produced before a court which sent him in police custody till September 21, Nagrale said.

His blood-stained clothes were seized. They would be sent for forensic analysis to find out if it is the victim's blood, the commissioner added.

A Special Investigation Team has been formed to conduct the probe, he said.

"Assistant Commissioner of Police Jyotsna Rasam will be the investigation officer. The probe will be completed within a month, and the case will be tried before a fast-track court as the chief minister announced," the commissioner said.

"As the victim was unconscious, her statement could not be recorded. Therefore police are as yet clueless about what exactly happened. But it will be ascertained during the investigation," Nagrale said.

The probe so far has revealed the involvement of only one person in the crime, the commissioner said.

On Friday the police had booked the accused under IPC sections 307 (attempt to murder), 376 (rape), 323 (assault) and 34 (common intention). After the victim died, section 302 (murder) was added, while section 34 was dropped as the involvement of any other person in the crime has not come to light, a police release said.

State BJP vice-president Chitra Wagh called for a new act on the lines of SC/ST Atrocities Act so that the culprits involved in cases of atrocities against women do not get bail easily.

## Maha CM condemns Sakinaka rape-murder case

MAHARASHTRA CHIEF MINISTER Uddhav Thackeray termed the rape and murder of a woman in Mumbai's Sakinaka as a "blot on humanity", and promised a fast-track trial

in the case. He asserted that the perpetrator would be punished severely. "The trial in the case will be done on a fast track and the victim, who succumbed to injuries, will get justice,"

Thackeray said in a statement. The minister said he has discussed the case with state Home Minister Dilip Walse Patil, Mumbai Police Commissioner Hemant Nagrale. —PTI

## We do business with honesty and integrity: Newslaundry

ONLINE NEWS PLATFORM NewsLaundry on Saturday said it conducted their business "honestly and with integrity" and will cooperate with the Income Tax department authorities who surveyed their office.

"We have nothing to hide and have done everything by the book and are not in any breach or violation of any law. We conduct our business honestly and with integrity," NewsLaundry co-

founder Abhinandan Sekhri said in a message posted on his Twitter handle.

Sekhri said the tax team told him he "can not" speak to his lawyer and the law requires him to comply "without seeking legal advice" adding that the officials were courteous and professional.

He said "no signed hash value of the data copied" was provided to him and that he considered this as violation of his fundamental right to privacy.

A hash value is a numeric value that uniquely identifies data. Hash values represent large amounts of data as much smaller numeric values, so they are used with digital signatures.

The tax department surveyed the office of the news portal located at Sarvodaya Enclave in south Delhi on Friday along with that of another digital news platform NewsClick in Saidulajab area (south Delhi) on charges of alleged tax evasion.

Sekhri said the tax team comprising about 6-7 people arrived at their office around 12.15 pm and left around 12.40 am on Saturday.

"We searched and looked through all computer devices at the premises. My personal mobile phone, laptop and a couple of office machines were taken control of and all the data on them downloaded by the IT team," he said.

Sekhri said this was the second visit by the tax authorities to his office, the first being in June, and they had given "all documents related to our funding and accounts" to the officials then.

A year ago, the government announced the new National Education Policy that made school and college education unrecognisable from what it had been since 1986.

In schools, the 10+2 pattern was replaced with a 5+3+3+4 structure of foundational, preparatory, middle, and secondary education.

Higher education was opened to foreign universities, and the UGC and AICTE were dismantled.

The undergraduate programme became four years long, but students who wanted to get off midway, could with a suitable degree.

And it was mandated that by 2040, there would be no single-stream institutions; only multidisciplinary colleges and universities.

With the pandemic hopefully near its end, the time for implementing the changes has arrived.

How will going to school and college change over the next year? How prepared are institutions, teachers, and students for the changes? How will we tackle the inevitable disruptions that will follow?
